3 Night Discovery Cruise

Departing: 4, 11, 18, 25[^] January 2019 and 1, 8, 22 February 2019

This cruise is an introduction to the beautiful and historic Murray River between Walker Flat and Murray Bridge. Aboard the paddle wheeler PS Murray Princess, you will cruise through spectacular riverlands and enjoy the great variety of flora and fauna. You will take a nature walk, get up close to the river birdlife on board the 'Dragon-Fly' flat-bottomed boat, visit the township of Murray Bridge and learn about the food and wine of this famous region.

4 Night Outback Heritage Cruise

Departing 7, 14, 21, 28 January 2019 and 4, 11, 25 February 2019

This cruise takes you north on the great Murray River from the historic river port of Mannum to Blanchetown. Experience the magic of the spectacular scenery from towering cliffs to expansive farmlands.
